#### ADDITIONAL IDEAS, SIGHTS AND SOUNDS FOR KIDS

The Animal Learning Center is a highlight for many with live viewing of baby animal births. Learn about our lowa livestock and see how much lowa farmers care for their animals. We're of course partial to the farrowing display where families can see sows and their newborn piglets. Plus, you can sign up for text alerts on baby animal births by texting BABY to 75782.

While you're near the Animal Learning Center, be sure to make your way to the Sensory Learning Experience area that is new as of the 2022 lowa State Fair. The fair is known for its unique sights and sounds, but this location offers a special opportunity to take in the fair in a different way.

Sea Lion Splash is a unique show that will have you cheering and laughing as sea lions balance balls, shoot hoops, dance and perform handstands.

Mutton Bustin' – "The Toughest Sport on Wool" will give boys and girls, ages three to six years old and weighing less than 60 pounds, a chance to ride a sheep for a full six seconds. Riders are timed and placed with a chance to compete in the finals, just like the big rodeo!

And finally, don't forget to sign up for fun contests like Bubble Gum Blowing, Pie Eating, Pedal Tractor Pull, Scavenger Hunt, Mom Calling, Children's Singing, Checkers Tournament and even the Pigtail, PonyTail, Braid, Mullet & MoHawk Contest.

It's a rich tradition for fairgoers to stroll through the livestock barns and milking parlors where kids can see farm animals first hand. Be sure to see the Milking Parlor, Boulevard of Dairy Breeds, Cattle Corner, Avenue of Breeds, Pig Place, Horse Haven, Sheep Stop and of course, the Super Bull and Big Boar.

There is a fun splash/fountain area for the kids to run and cool off in. Make sure you have some dry clothes to change them in afterward.



We're in love with Little Hands on the Farm, because this experience teaches kids the importance of agriculture and how it affects their daily lives in a fun and interactive way. Kids are greeted with a gathering basket and apron at the farm gate, then they proceed along a path that includes a garden, grain bin, hog barn (!!), apple orchard, chicken coop, tractor shed, sheep barn and dairy barn. After gathering particular items along the way, kids get the chance to sell these items at the Little Hands on the Farm Farmers' Market for a Little Hands dollar to spend at the Grocery Store for such items as a piece of fruit, a granola bar or an ice cream sandwich.
