LOST ISLAND WATERPARK

Iowa's largest waterpark, Lost Island, is waiting for you! With 11 major waterslides, a lazy river, wave pool, multiple large pools, and interactive play areas for the little ones all in one place, this waterpark has something for everyone in your family. Enjoy plenty of options for lunch and snacks while you are there including pizza, tacos, burgers and soft serve ice cream.

WATERSLIDES

Get ready for some thrills! Lost Island has 11 major water slides that you will love. The Wailua Kupua is a unique mix between a water slide and roller coaster that uses hydromagnetic technology. Check out the Ta Katipo for a fast-paced racing water slide. The Molokini Crater includes a massive 60-foot funnel and is sure to thrill even the most adventurous riders. For a toilet bowl style slide, visit the bright orange Tangerine Tempest. For a big thrill, visit Lost Soul Falls, the tall free-fall slide where you will drop 28 feet per second.

KAILAHI RIVER

Not a fan of the more intense slides? The Kailahi River is just the thing for you. This lazy river winds around the park and is the perfect spot for relaxing and spending time in the sun and is available for all ages.

TSUNAMI BAY

Visit Tsunami Bay, Lost Island's zero entry wave pool, to enjoy the water and cool off. Ride on a tube or take a swim and jump waves in the shallower area. After enjoying the pool, make sure to visit the nearby Fiji Fruits and Snacks for some soft-serve ice cream!

LOST ISLAND THEME PARK

The Lost Island Theme Park offers thrill rides, family rides, games, playgrounds, arcades and water rides. The park is spread out among five unique realms - Fire, Water, Air, Earth and Spirit. Find your favorite and spend the day exploring all that this theme park has to offer!

MURA (FIRE)

Fiery thrills, a spinning coaster, and a quest inside the volcano, what more could you ask for? Mura, the fire themed area of the park, has a lot to offer visitors who are looking for big thrills. Make sure to visit Volkanu: Quest for the Golden Idol, a 4D interactive adventure ride located inside of the Mura volcano.

AWA (WATER)

Giant squids, whirling waves, and schools of fish can all be found in the Awa water themed area of the park. The Awaati Battle is a fan favorite, where riders get to use a water cannon to shoot other boats and guests on the shore.

UDARA (AIR)

Visit Udara to be up in the air! Giant swings, a suspended looping coaster and flying contraptions can all be found in this air themed area of the park. Check out the Kapulele Gliders to fly high in the air with the butterflies, or visit the Nopuko Air Coaster for some extreme thrills!

YUTA (EARTH)

An ancient tree, bumper cars, and a serpent roller coaster are just some of the highlights of the Yuta area of the park. Visit Yuta Falls for a thrilling water ride experience, or enjoy fun for the whole family at the Kukui Station's bumper cars.

TAMARIKI (SPIRIT)

The center of the islands where you should watch for signs of the elusive Tamariki and enjoy pint-sized rides for your youngest family members. Ohu Hoppers offers a fun frog themed ride, or visit Mama Pezaki to ride around in the belly of a giant tropical fish.

THE OTHER PLACE
