The awarding of the scholarship is to be conducted by the following rules and regulations.

1. Students meeting the following requirements are eligible to apply for the scholarship:
  - a. Student is a child or dependent of a part-time, active employee or a full-time, active employee of Iowa Select Farms, LLP.
  - b. Student is a child or dependent of a contracted site manager, owner-operator or contract grower.
  - c. Student is a part-time employee or contractor for Iowa Select Farms.
  - d. While all degrees are eligible, preference will be given to students pursuing (or planning to pursue) a degree in agriculture, including, but not limited to a degree in animal science, agronomy, ag studies, ag business, ag education, ag systems technology, ag engineering, or ag communications.
  - e. Student is enrolled (or plans to enroll) full-time at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university located in the state of Iowa.
  - f. Student maintains a minimum GPA of 2.8.
2. Scholarships will be awarded on a discretionary basis, taking into consideration each applicant’s academic success, extracurricular activities, career goals, and financial need.
3. Applicants from prior years, including winners, are eligible to reapply; however, the maximum total scholarship a student may receive, taking into consideration all prior years, is \$6,000.
4. Students wishing to apply for the scholarship must apply using the official application form.
